CARES ACT DISCLOSURE

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed into law to provide economic relief from COVID-19. One section of the CARES Act established a Higher Education Emergency Relief fund and sent money to schools to use for emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the pandemic. Pure Aesthetics received \$32,000.00.

Pure Aesthetics secured its first round of CARES Act emergency funding for students impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Award amounts were equally distributed to eligible Title IV recipients received \$530 and who met the following criteria:

- 1. Must be current recipient of Title IV Student Federal Financial Aid, and
- 2. Must have attended a ground campus on or before March 13, 2020, and
- 3. Must have been required to move to an online classroom environment due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and
- 4. Must be currently attending Pure Aesthetics.

Eligible students who qualify for CARES funding received an email with application instructions.
