



Student Right-to-Know Act

The Student Right-to-Know Act, passed by Congress in 1990. The Student Right-to-Know (SRTK) is a federally-mandated public disclosure of specific college-related information, as per the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations (CFR): Title 34 — Part 668*. The following focuses on sub-sections of the two basic laws that mandate specific college information:

CFR: Title 34 — Part 668.46: Information on Completion or Graduation Rates*

The college completion rates or graduation rates (including transfer rates and student athlete rates — Part 668.49) will be made accessible to the public. The rates are obtained from yearly IPEDS — Pure Aesthetics Natural Skincare School Graduation Rate Survey submissions and are currently coordinated through the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES).

Publication Requirements

PA completion, graduation rates are updated annually (July 1st - June 30th). Crime activities are made public by October 1st of each year to all current/prospective students in the areas of admissions, literature, brochures, catalogs, and websites, or anytime a student enters a financial obligation with a school (for the exception of application fees).

CFR: Title 34 — Part 668.47: Institutional Security Policies and Crime Statistics*

Public Law 101-542: The Higher Education Act of 1965 was amended via the current Student Right-to-Know and Campus Security Act through Public Laws 102-26, 102-208 and 102-325. The regulations require the college to release information about campus safety policies and procedures and certain crime statistics. The Act also entails additional information including security policies.

Pure Aesthetics Natural Skincare School reports these calculations to several external entities/organizations, one of them being the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). The NCES is a primary federal entity for collecting and analyzing data related to education in the U.S. and other nations. NCES is a part of the U.S. Department of Education and the Institute of Education Sciences. NCES fulfills a congressional mandate to collect, collate, analyze, and report complete statistics on the condition of American education; conduct and publish reports; and review and report on education activities internationally.
